Pupil Premium - School Uniform Vouchers

We would like to make parents aware of a uniform voucher service that is available to all parents of children who are in receipt of free school meals or eligible for Pupil Premium funding. We are now using a portion of our Pupil Premium funding to offer parents a £30 uniform voucher per pupil. These vouchers can be used to purchase any two items of school uniform (or equivalent) at Keywear in Truro. If you are in receipt of income support, income based job seeker's allowance, income related employment support and allowance, child tax credits (with an annual income of no more than $\pounds 16,190$) then your child may be eligible for Pupil Premium Funding. If

you think your child may be eligible for Pupil Premium funding / free school meals, please call the school office to fill out a short form or look on our school website. Pupil Premium funding is available to children in all year groups and is in addition to the Universal Infant Free School meals which is available to all KS1 pupils. Every child who is registered as eligible for pupil premium generates valuable income for the school and this eligibility will also help you access financial assistance with various school costs such as trips, clubs and music tuition.

Drum Kit Available

We have a child sized school drum kit that over the years we have loaned out to children wishing to try out this great instrument. The kit has now become available again and is up for grabs if anyone would like to borrow it for their child. There is no formal arrangement in place or time limit - you can simply use it for as long as your child wishes.
