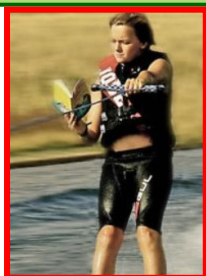

Please can we politely request that parents do not park or temporarily stop on the double yellow lines opposite the school entrance. This road is a necessary crossing area for many children and families each morning and afternoon. It is therefore of extreme importance that vehicles do not obstruct this area in any way. 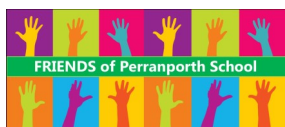
