
#### Perranporth School Christmas Writing Competition 2021



#### PACE - Christmas Tree Appeal



Perranzabuloe Action for Climate Emergency (PACE), are asking for your support to help contribute decorations for their Christmas tree to be displayed at the festival at St Piran's Church, Penhallow.
