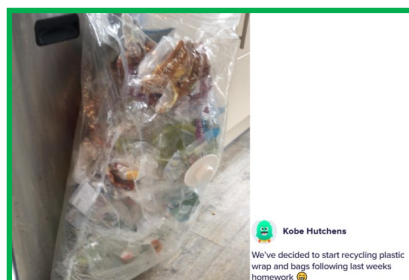
School Litter Pick Morning

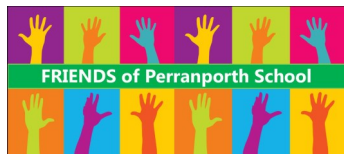
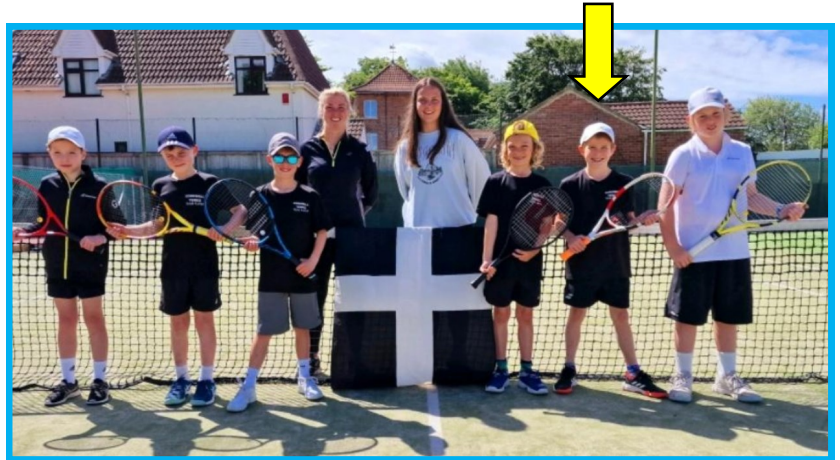

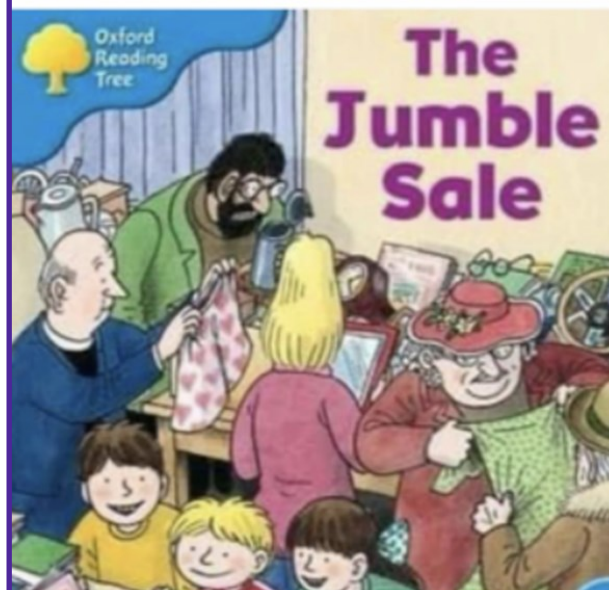
