

Relationships Sex Health Education - RSHE Week

These days, there is a vast amount of sometimes confusing information about relationships and sex on the internet, on TV and in magazines. Therefore, as part of our school's Personal, Social and Health Education learning, your child will be receiving Relationship and Sex Education lessons (RSE) in the coming week. We will be having a blocked unit of work from the 4th – 8th July, but further related sessions will also continue as part of our regular PSHE lessons. The key aims of RSE are to:



- Provide accurate and relevant information about the physical and emotional changes that children and young people will experience through their formative years and into adulthood.
- Establish an awareness of the importance of a loving family environment, including the responsibilities of parenthood.
- Foster self-awareness and self-esteem.
- Develop a sense of responsibility and respect for themselves and others.

A summary of the RSE your child is receiving will be sent out on the Class Dojo at the end of each day so that you are familiar with what has been discussed. Parents have the right to request that their child be withdrawn from some or all aspects of sex education delivered as part of statutory RSE.
