Reception & KS1 disco will be from 4.30-5.30pm and KS2 from 5.45-6.45pm.



NumBots - Maths Platform

We're delighted to let you know about a new app we're using to support children's maths at Perranporth School. The creators of Times Tables Rock Stars have produced a platform for boosting addition and subtraction skills, called NumBots. This app is primarily focused towards children in Key Stage 1, but any child who finds it helpful can use it.



ber bonds and addition and subtraction facts. These are critical foundations in maths so we are excited by the impact NumBots will have.

<u>Logging In</u> - The children have been shown how to login and have brought home a username today. They might need some help navigating to the website and entering the details but once they're in, they just need some quiet space to get on with the games for 5 minutes.

Please ask your child's teacher if they are struggling to login. Maths Circle (the creators of NumBots) cannot provide username and password information to parents, even during school holidays or out of hours.

Important: please don't allow siblings, friends or family to answer for children, but do support your child if they're having trouble.

<u>Little and often</u> - In order to get the best out of NumBots children should regularly play for short bursts. So we would ask you to give them 5 minutes sessions on a regular basis.

Game Types

- 1. Story Mode the emphasis is on learning the ideas and concepts behind addition and subtraction so it features more diagrams, shapes and question styles.
- Challenge Mode the emphasis is more on speed of recall of key facts, like number bonds to 10, doubling small numbers or adding & taking away in your head. Please let your child's teacher know if you have any questions or comments.
