#### **Anti Bullying Week**



#### Cornwall Christmas Box

This year we are helping to support Cornwall Christmas Box by offering the school as a location for collections of boxes. Mrs Wordley has kindly agreed to collect any donation boxes and transport them to the centre for us. What is a Christmas Box?

This is a great way to help less fortunate families by ensuring they have what they need to make a special Christmas. Each box contains enough food for Christmas dinner with all the extra little goodies, treats like mince pies and biscuits, and of course Christmas pudding – which all go to make up a feast



for a family in need. Due to storage and distribution limitations we can't accept fresh food but there are plenty of good things to eat that can still be included. A typical box costs around £30-£40 but you can share the cost by getting together with friends, neighbours and colleagues to fill a box together. The boxes will be distributed by Cornwall Council's 'Together for Families' team and some Family Hubs to families in need.

If you'd like to support this very worthy cause, all you need to do is:

- Print out the checklist: Cornwall Christmas Box Christmas dinner in a box!
- Get shopping! Make sure that everything you buy for the box will still be in date at Christmas.
- Cover a close-able cardboard box in Christmas paper we need it to have proper close-able portions that fold over so we can transport the boxes more
- Tick off each item on the checklist as you put it into the box. You can add other items too, but we need to be clear – no alcohol, and we'd prefer nothing break-
- Drop it off at school by the 9th December 2022

- Packet of yummy, sweet biscuits
- ☐ Box of chocolates
- Packet of 'nibbles' (crisps or similar)
- Chocolate log or Christmas cake Soft drink (plastic bottle & no alcohol please)
- You're welcome to add other Christmas treats to your

box (please don't include alcohol, cigarettes, vouchers or any perishable food).
