### What is a Christmas Box?

This is a great way to help less fortunate families by ensuring they have what they need to make a special Christmas. Each box contains enough food for

Christmas dinner with all the extra little goodies, treats like mince pies and biscuits, and of course Christmas pudding – which all go to make up a feast for a family in need. Due to storage and distribution limitations we can't accept fresh food but there are plenty of good things to eat that can still be included. A typical box costs around £30-£40 but you can share the cost by getting together with friends, neighbours and colleagues to fill a

box together. The boxes will be distributed by Cornwall Council's 'Together for Families' team and some Family Hubs to families in need.

If you'd like to support this very worthy cause, all you need to do is:

- Print out the checklist: <u>Cornwall Christmas Box Christmas</u> <u>dinner in a box!</u>
- Get shopping! Make sure that everything you buy for the box will still be in date at Christmas.
- Cover a close-able cardboard box in Christmas paper we need it to have proper close-able portions that fold over so we can transport the boxes more easily!
- Tick off each item on the checklist as you put it into the box.
  You can add other items too, but we need to be clear no alcohol, and we'd prefer nothing breakable either.
- Drop it off at school by the 9th December 2022
