## Musical Composer at Perranporth

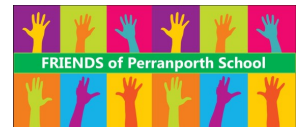

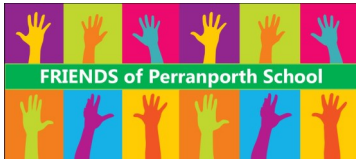
