If your child requires a planned absence from school for medical appointments, dental appointments etc, please collect an Absence Application Form from the School Office. <u>The school cannot authorise absences</u> for the purpose of holiday or other avoidable absences during term time. Absences not authorised by the school may result in issuing a Penalty Notice or prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Thank you for your understanding.

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
