- ◆ Household bedding (bed sheets, pillow cases and duvet covers)

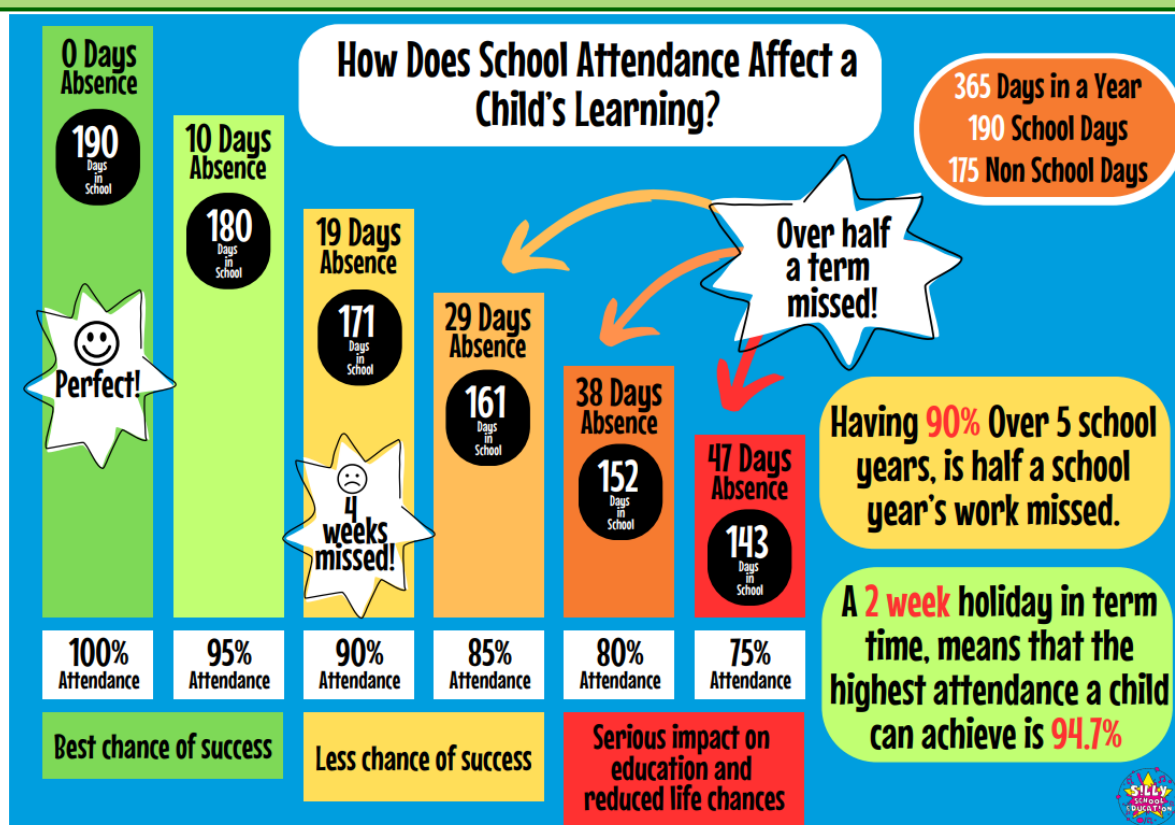
They DO NOT accept:

- ◆ Corporate clothing and workwear
- ◆ Textile off cuts, yarns or threaded material
