- The school is planned to open in September 2026 (our current Y4 would be the first planned cohort)
- The school will grow from the bottom up, with only one cohort entering each year.
- The site is planned for Liskey Hill, just a short walk up the hill from our school.
- We also heard that there is the potential for facilities to be shared with the community.
