We hope these little moments help all of the children and families feel confident and ready for the coming school year ahead.

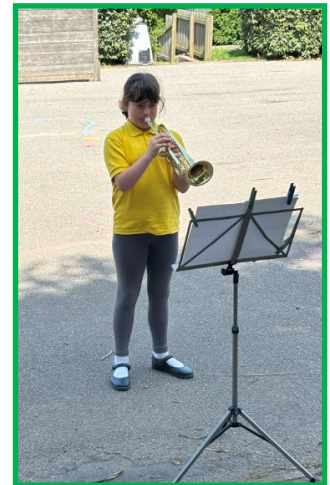
